Worm Control Plans

Welcome to the Oakhill '2022-2023' Equine Worm Control Plan. As per previous years, our aim is to ensure that your horse receives a responsible worm control plan.

Why is responsible worming important?

Responsible use of wormers is incredibly important to help prevent the development of resistance to the wormers currently available. With no new products in the pipeline, diagnostic testing is more important than ever to ensure that wormers aren't being used unnecessarily.

A closer look at our plans

Our worm control plans consists of a combination of diagnostic testing and the correct use of wormers when required. Should your horse have a positive result on any diagnostic test on our plan, you will receive a suitable wormer **free of charge**.

Similar to last year, this year we are offering two options for our Worm Control Plan - the traditional 'Worm Control Plan' and the recently launched 'Advanced Worm Control Plan.'

The 'Worm Control Plan,' as per previous years, allows you to perform all the diagnostic tests yourself and consists of three faecal worm egg counts, the EquiSal Tapeworm saliva test and a wormer for small redworm to be administered after the first Winter's frost.

Last year, we launched our very successful 'Advanced Worm Control Plan' - an entire diagnostic-led plan specifically designed for those of you who do not want to worm unless absolutely necessary and for those horses that are challenging to perform the EquiSal saliva test. The 'Advanced Worm Control Plan' uses a blood test for tapeworm and small redworm in addition to three faecal worm egg counts for adult roundworm. Bloods for tapeworm and small redworm should be taken at the same time in Autumn.

The small redworm blood test is not suitable for horses with persistently high faecal worm egg counts; these horses will be prescribed a wormer for small redworm as part of the plan.

How to join

As per previous years, you may join the plan by contacting reception, by completing our online form or by filling out the form on page 4 of this booklet. Payment is required at sign-up.

If you are a member of our Equine Care Plan Plus or Premium you will automatically receive a 'Worm Control Plan.' If you wish to upgrade to the 'Advanced Plan,' you may do so by contacting reception on 01772 861300. A fee of £30 will apply and is payable at the time of upgrade.
